Get to know the consultation Australian Curriculum

The consultation version of the learning area curriculum is available in three formats. Choose the one that best suits you:

- All elements: the introductory information and all the curriculum details
- Scope and sequence: proposed content descriptions and achievement standards only
- Comparative information: current and proposed content descriptions and achievement standards.

The general capabilities and cross-curriculum priorities are presented in one format only. This format includes the current and proposed revisions.

The survey can be completed individually or you can submit a group response.

The proposed content descriptions and elaborations have codes. Use these codes when you want to make reference to a specific content description or elaboration in the survey.

- cross-curriculum priorities you will be able to select the ones you want to give feedback on, once you start the survey.
